Photography2 or 3 \$30/Semester or \$60/Year
Ceramics2 or 3- \$30/Semester or \$60/Year
Sculpture 2 - \$30/Semester or \$60/Year
Fibers 2-\$30.00/Semester or \$60/Year
AP Art- \$50/Semester or \$100/year

These fees are allocated directly to consumable art supplies the student will use in class. By ordering in bulk, rather than requiring a supply list, we are able to save families money and time.

The fees can be turned in to the teacher in person where a receipt will be provided to the student. Fees may also be submitted online using My School Bucks by selecting the course associated with the teacher.

Any fees that are not paid first semester will carry over to the second semester and continue throughout your student's time at Shadow Creek High School. Delinquent fees will result in students being placed on the campus fine list. Once on the fine list students can be removed once the fees are paid. Please communicate directly with your student's teacher, if necessary.
